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# Avalon

Situated on the Chavannes side of Les Gets and with dramatic sweeping views of the valley, chalet Avalon commands an elevated, south facing position just a few minutes from the heart of the picturesque savoyard village of Les Gets.

This large private chalet spans three floors and totals just over 400m<sup>2</sup> of luxurious home-from-home comfort. The ground floor of the property can be accessed through the main entrance, or via the boot room with a separate staircase leading to the second of two principal suites, which has its own en suite bathroom and kitchenette.

Upon entering the chalet you are immediately struck by the sense of space created by the open plan design and the adjacent floor to ceiling windows. Moving through the property past the luxurious kitchen and dining area you'll find an ultra comfy living area complete with designer sofas, log fire, and a separate cosy snug, all the while taking in the spectacular views which the aforementioned windows take full advantage of. However the lower ground floor is where the fun really starts in chalet Avalon, here you'll find the luxurious spa facilities alongside a state of the art cinema room and bar area complete with library and table football.

From the clever layout of the two master suites, to the stylish elegance of the Bocci lighting and Edra furnishings, chalet Avalon has been meticulously designed from the ground up with style and luxury in mind. With a range of luxury spa & relaxation facilities and a whole host of in chalet entertainment, this property will be sure to impress even the most discerning of travellers.







## The Bar

# Spa Facilities

The spa facilities here are extensive and include a salt stone sauna and hammam, alongside a Gessi waterfall shower and separate relaxation area, but the icing on the cake has to be the custom sunken hot tub to the rear of the property. The bespoke tiled hot tub is cleverly concealed beneath a sliding section of the rear deck and has been positioned to take in the breathtaking valley view, the only downside is that you may find it difficult to get back out again!

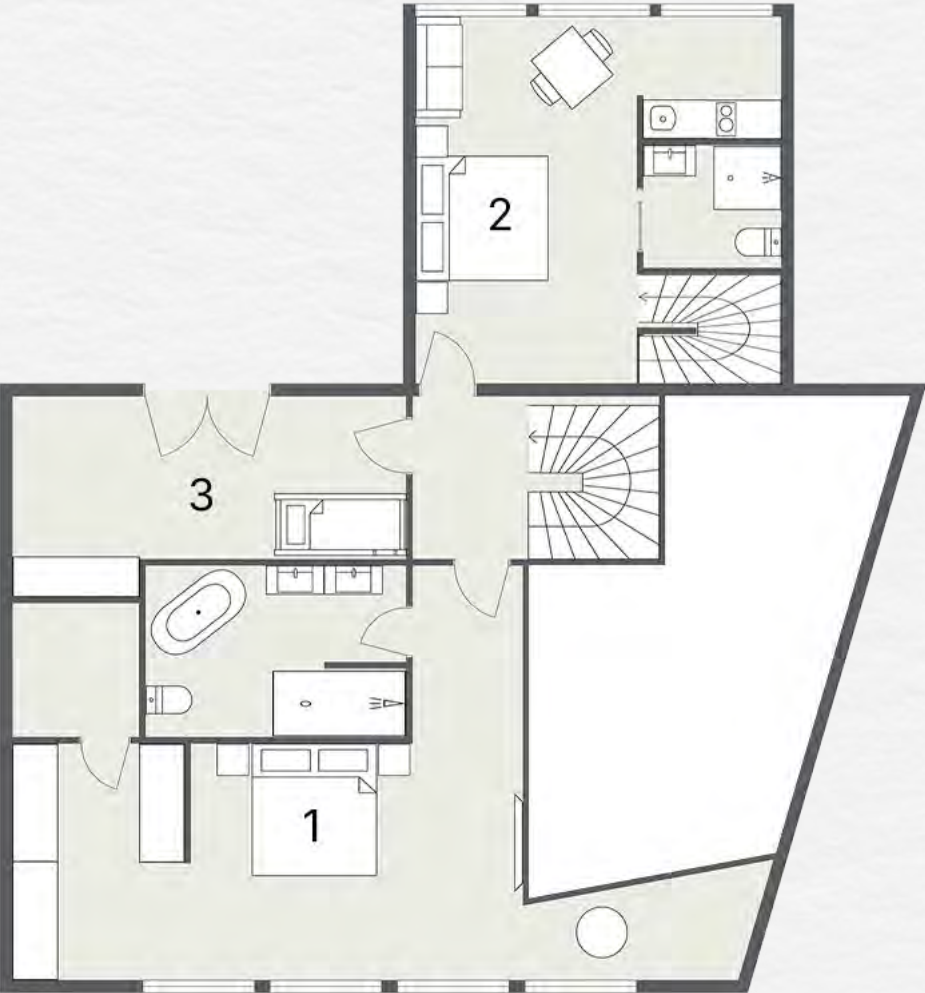

Les Gets is located in the Haute Savoie and is one of the most northerly of the French Alpine resorts, less than one hour from Chamonix, and benefiting from the Mont Blanc microclimate. It forms part of the Portes du Soleil, the largest ski area in the world comprising of 12 Franco-Swiss ski resorts that will keep you busy for many holidays to come.

Off mountain Les Gets and the surrounding area offers so much to its visitors that it would be easy not to ski at all. There are the basics such as local cinema, large swimming pools and an aquatic centre, bowling, an open-air ice rink, ice hockey, parapenting, ice diving, snowmobiling, tobogganing and snowshoeing.
