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Griffonner

Chalet Griffonner was newly developed in 2021 to the highest standards and is situated near the end of a quiet lane perched high up on the coveted sunny side of the Vallée d'Aulps. With panoramic views over the valley below the property enjoys peaceful sunbathed afternoons, yet remains only a stones throw from Morzine's vibrant Savoyard town centre and the Super Morzine Gondola, placing the vast 650m ski area of the Portes du Soleil right at your ski tips.

Making the most of the aforementioned panoramic views and the abundance of natural light was at the forefront of the architect's plans, with balconies, terraces and open spaces incorporated at every possible stage as the property ascends the mountainside over 4 luxurious and meticulously designed levels.

The ground and first floor of the chalet are certainly not to be overlooked and are made up of an all important boot room and garage alongside three of the Spacious en suite bedrooms and the luxurious sauna and treatment room, but it's once you arrive at the second floor that the sense of space and the open plan nature of the property really starts to shine. This section of the property has been devoted entirely to luxury open plan living, with an abundance of comfortable seating, a cosy fireplace and a luxurious kitchen / dining area all complimented by floor to ceiling windows which look out over a large split level terrace complete with al fresco dining and a perfectly positioned hot tub which overlooks the majesty of the valley below.

If you're lucky enough to be staying in the master suite at chalet Griffonner then you are in for a real treat. The entire third floor of the chalet has been devoted to one large double bedroom complete with a luxurious en suite bathroom and its very own private terrace with a beautiful seating area and some of the best views in town, what better place to take your morning coffee and contemplate the adventure of the day to come.





The Outlook

The positioning of chalet Griffonner is such that even before you step into the property the outlook is clear, broad sweeping views of the valley below. The property has been meticulously designed to take advantage of this outlook at every turn, with terraces and balconies galore and floor to ceiling windows throughout, this property takes indoor/outdoor living to a new level.



The Master Suite

The master suite here occupies the entire top floor of the property, giving an extra sense of pure luxury to those who are lucky enough to be staying there. The sense of light and space is arguably even more present here as the suite is perched at the very top of the property and makes the absolute most of the best mountain vista that Morzine has to offer. There is a large double bed, a spacious ensuite complete with shower and standalone bath, a comfortable indoor seating area and a private balcony with more outdoor seating. If it wasn't for the fact that the rest of chalet Griffonner is so incredible, you could almost be forgiven for not wanting to leave your suite.
