Spread over 425m², the chalet sleeps up to 14 guests across 7 individually designed suites, each named after a famous Cambridge University college – the walls of each room depicting aspects of Cambridge both old and new. The chalet offers guests a fabulous living space taking up almost the entire first floor and the wellness suite features an outdoor hot tub, soothing hammam, private gym and Bamford massage treatment room. A private cinema, pool table and mood lit bar set the scene for a perfect mountain getaway.

The chalet is located in Meribel 1600. Meribel Centre is only a 5 minute drive away and only a 2 minute drive from the Doron piste which offers easy access to the main lifts of the Chaudanne. 
The First Floor





What drives us every day is a passion to be creative and innovative in all that we do and particularly our food and drink. We genuinely aim to take the best elements of service and hospitality that we experience and incorporate those into our own style, to deliver what we believe is the most innovative ski chalet experience out there.
